**Terms and Conditions for Paid Registration for ISMG Cybersecurity Week 2025 **

Introduction

This year, the flagship ISMG Cybersecurity Summits held in Bengaluru, New Delhi and Mumbai are celebrating their 10th anniversary! To mark this milestone, we have transformed our flagship summits into a single, powerful event - **ISMG Cybersecurity Week 2025**.

Thank you for registering for the **ISMG Cybersecurity Week 2025** (hereafter referred to as "Summit"). Whether you submit your registration personally or through a proxy, the Summit's Terms and Conditions (hereafter referred to as "Terms") apply to you. "Attendee" for purposes of these Terms will include all participants at the Summit, including Exhibitors and Attendees. By participating in this Summit, you agree to these Terms, so please read them carefully and thoroughly.

Information Security Media Group (hereafter referred to as "ISMG"), the organizer of this Summit, reserves the exclusive right to restrict or deny access to any entity or individual at its sole discretion. You must be 21 years of age or older to be eligible to participate.

These Terms govern your registration and participation in the Summit.

Accuracy of Information

Attendees must provide accurate and complete information during the registration process. Any false or misleading information provided may result in the rejection of the registration or denial of access to the Event.

Payment

Registration fees are due at the time of registration unless otherwise specified. After registration, the payment link will be shared with the Attendee via the email address provided. Payment must be made in the currency specified by the Event organizers. Failure to pay the registration fees may result in the cancellation of the registration.

Confirmation

Upon successful registration and payment, Attendees will receive a confirmation email with details of their registration. It is the Attendee's responsibility to retain this confirmation for reference.

Cancellation and Refunds

Delegate Cancellation and Refund Policy:

Registration fees are non-refundable. If you are unable to attend, you may nominate another person to attend in your place. To transfer your registration to another attendee, please email us at **smishra@ismg.io** with a copy of your original Event ticket and CC the person to whom you'd like to transfer the ticket.

Event Cancellation or Rescheduling

In the unlikely event that ISMG cancels the Summit, attendees will receive a full refund or the option to transfer their registration to a future ISMG event.

If the Event is rescheduled, all registrations will automatically be moved to the new date. Attendees who are unable to attend on the rescheduled date are eligible for a full refund upon request.

Force Majeure Clause

ISMG shall not be held responsible for any cancellations or changes caused by natural disasters, pandemics, government regulations, strikes or other unforeseen circumstances beyond our control. In such cases, ISMG will make reasonable efforts to reschedule or provide alternative participation options.

Substitution and Badge Policy

Substitution of registrations can be made at any time until the start date of **ISMG Cybersecurity Week 2025**, but substitutions must be within the registered Attendee's company. All substitutions require ISMG approval and are subject to discretion.

Attendee badges/credentials cannot be shared at any time. Badges/credentials are issued exclusively to the registered Attendees, who must collect and wear them at all times during the Summit. ISMG reserves the right to dismiss any Attendee violating these rules and may also prohibit their participation in future ISMG Summits.

An **ISMG Cybersecurity Week 2025** badge for a specific location grants entry to the overall Summit at that location only; however, it does not guarantee admission to every session, lounge or meeting area. Admission is subject to venue capacity and additional criteria. For example, certain sessions may be restricted, by invitation only, with access only to preregistered Attendees.

Group Discount Program

To qualify for the group discount and gain admission to **ISMG Cybersecurity Week 2025**, complete payment for all registrations is required. Terms and Conditions for Group Discount Program

General: Participation in the promotion constitutes acceptance of these Terms and Conditions. The Company's decision regarding all aspects of the promotion shall be final and binding.

Eligibility: This promotion is open to individuals aged 21 years and above, who have purchased passes (hereafter referred to as "Purchasers") from ISMG.

Promotional Period: The promotional period begins on January 30, 2025, and ends on April 30, 2025. The Company reserves the right to extend or terminate the promotion at its discretion without prior notice.

Offer Details: Purchasers who buy paid group passes during the promotional period will be eligible to receive free additional passes (hereafter referred to as "Extra Passes") as specified on the registration page.

Redemption: Extra Passes are subject to availability and must be redeemed within the validity period specified in the promotional material. These passes have to be redeemed in exchange of a ticket/registration for the Summit to attend the Summit. The Summit Pass is intended for information security and IT practitioners. The last date to submit the names for the issuance of the delegate ticket is April 25, 2025.

Limitations: Each Purchaser is entitled only up to the maximum number of Extra Passes as specified in the promotional material. The Company reserves the right to limit the number of Extra Passes issued per Purchaser or per transaction.

Non-Transferable: Extra Passes are non-transferable, non-exchangeable, and cannot be redeemed for cash or any other form of compensation.

Exclusions: The promotion does not apply to individuals in sales roles, business development, consulting, security vendors or solution providers.

Modification and Termination: The Company reserves the right to modify, suspend or terminate the promotion at any time without prior notice, for any reason, including - but not limited to - fraud, technical failures or any other factor beyond the Company's reasonable control.

Payment Terms

Currency Exchange Rate Disclaimer: Client/Cardholder confirms acknowledgment and acceptance of a potential gain/loss incurred due to any adjustments made by their bank to the currency exchange rate. ISMG will not be liable or responsible for any loss incurred by the Client/Cardholder from an adjustment made due to the currency exchange rate, nor will ISMG pursue the Client/Cardholder for collection if that adjustment should be made in favor of the Client/Cardholder.

Submission of a registration online, by phone or email, constitutes an official registration and intent to attend the Summit. Invoices are payable upon receipt, and full payment must be made to gain entry to the Summit. Please note that ISMG does not accept cash payments on-site at the Summit.

You agree that in the unlikely event that ISMG cannot resolve your payment issue and you dispute the credit card charge, your electronic statement may be used as evidence that said charge is valid and justified.

Use of Multimedia at the Summit

To comply with global data privacy laws, ISMG imposes certain restrictions on the use of multimedia at its events (e.g., photography, video and audio recording, online streaming, and all upcoming forms of media). An Attendee is permitted to use hand-held cameras and/or smartphones to take photographs and capture digital images for personal, non-commercial use, provided the photography does not cause disruption. These photographs must not be published, sold, reproduced, broadcast, distributed or used for commercial purposes.

ISMG may hire professional service providers (photo/video/streaming/audio) to document and display the Event experience. ISMG may also use social media (e.g., Twitter, LinkedIn) to: (i) post real-time photos and videos to its social media feeds; and (ii) display select submissions from those

- Use ISMG Summit for commercial or advertising purposes. Summit organizers reserve the right to escort any Attendee from the Summit who is found to be soliciting and who is not an ISMG Exhibitor at the Summit.
- Post copyrighted content without permission from the owner.
