

TOP DATA BREACHES

AS REPORTED FOR WEEK OF SEPTEMBER 1, 2014

This week saw news of several data breaches, some confirmed and some still being investigated. Here's a look at the week's top incidents:

VICTIMS and BREACH DETAILS



 **868,000**
PEOPLE IMPACTED

INFORMATION COMPROMISED

Names, payment card numbers, expiration dates

HERE'S WHAT HAPPENED

The charitable organization confirmed that malware was used in the breach of a third-party vendor, affecting about 330 stores in 20 states.

INFORMATION COMPROMISED

Possibly payment card details

HERE'S WHAT HAPPENED

While the breach hasn't yet been confirmed, the home-improvement retailer says it is working with Symantec and FishNet Security to investigate the suspected incident.

Home Depot already faces a class-action lawsuit.

HERE'S WHAT HAPPENED

The FBI and U.S. Secret Service have confirmed they're investigating a suspected breach. A JPMorgan Chase spokeswoman says the bank is working with the agencies to identify the scope of the incident, but at this time details are unknown.

Celebrity iCloud Accounts

HERE'S WHAT HAPPENED

Apple on Sept. 2 said some celebrities' accounts – and photos and videos stored therein – “were compromised by a very targeted attack on usernames, passwords and security questions.” But some security experts questioned Apple's explanation of the breach. And they contended the company's iCloud service remains vulnerable to similar exploits.
